Living the Word in the Week Ahead:

What does believing in the Resurrection mean to you this week? We believe in the Resurrection of the body, how does this affect your life this week? "... you will be with me in Paradise" ... What aspects of eternal life comfort you this week?

As a Parish we've just taken time to remember Fr Tom and all those who've died over the last year, now we have the opportunity to do so again as a Deanery (all our sister parishes locally). **Please join us at our Deanery Requiem Mass this Tuesday at 11 am. Please note there will be no 9.30 Mass that day as the focus is our prayer together with the priests and people of our Deanery and to remember Fr Tom and all our deceased clergy.**

November Lists ~ taking time to remember those loved ones who have gone to the Lord and those Holy Souls who have no one to pray for them.

Sheets are available in the porch for you to take home to write lists of remembrance and envelopes are available in the porch carousel if you would like to request Mass for the Holy Souls. The envelopes can also be used to request Mass for your own intentions or family members. The sheets are presented at the altar for our prayers at each Mass during November. A book of blank sheets is by the Lady Altar so you can write your November Lists directly but you can post the Lists, together with your Mass intentions, into the Priest's House. Thank you.

Our Parish Pastoral Council and Open Synod Meeting will be held in the hall this Tuesday 12 Nov from 7.30-9 pm. Prior to this meeting we need nominations for the appointed roles (Chair etc.) so **please email or write to Fr Adrian with the nominee, a suggested role and your name.** *If you are nominating someone they must be aware of this and be attending on 12 Nov so you must ask them first, however, you can nominate yourself (please indicate if this is so).* **Fr Adrian and Yogi will collate the nominations and the appointment of members will be the first order of the open meeting. After this the Parish Council will need to arrange further meetings but the Parish open meeting will break into small groups to respond to the Synod Questionnaire on family life. All parish members are invited to attend as it is important that we take the opportunity to let the Synod know our opinions** on the Church's teaching on our personal life in Christ, family life, sacramental and civil marriage, divorce and remarriage, same-sex unions, family planning and contraception (see below).

An Important Message from Archbishop Peter

"The Holy Father has called an Extraordinary General Assembly of the Synod of Bishops in October 2014 on the theme: *Pastoral Challenges of the family in the context of evangelisation.* The General Secretary of the Synod of Bishops has asked every diocese in the world to respond to...a number of questions. I have appointed Lisette Blanchet Ball, one of our Diocesan Marriage and Family Life Co-Ordinators, to be the nominated person to receive and collate the responses from the Archdiocese, and she will then forward the synthesis of all these responses to Elizabeth Davies. Please note that the time frame for all this is extremely short and all responses must be sent to Lisette by the **30th November** to allow her to collate them and produce a synthesis which she will then forward to Elizabeth Davies at the Bishops' Conference... Parishioners can participate in this consultation either as individuals or as a group and will be able to access the Bishops' Conference Website and the Diocesan Website for further information and guidance. I am also writing to various groups and Associations in the Archdiocese, such as the UCM, CWL, Knights of St. Columba, and others, as well as the Religious, for their response to the questions posed in so far as they can... I thank you in advance for your help and co-operation in this consultation which will be our contribution to the preparation for the Extraordinary Synod in October 2014. With my gratitude and assurance of my prayers for you all, +Peter.
