### 3 August 2014 – 18<sup>th</sup> Sunday Ordinary Time

Entrance Antiphon: **O God, come to my assistance;  
O Lord, make haste to help me!**

**You are my rescuer, my help; O Lord, do not delay.**

Responsorial Psalm [144]: **You open wide your hand, O Lord,  
you grant our desires.**

A reading from the letter of St Paul to the Romans [8:35.37-39]  
*No created thing can ever come between us  
and the love of God made visible in Christ.*

Gospel Acclamation: **Man does not live on bread alone,  
but on every word that comes from the mouth of God.**

A reading from the Gospel according to Matthew [14:13-21]  
*They all ate as much as they wanted.*

Communion Antiphon:

**You have given us, O Lord, bread from heaven,  
endowed with the delights and sweetness in every taste.**

### 10 August 2014 – 19<sup>th</sup> Sunday Ordinary Time

Entrance Antiphon: **Look to your covenant, O Lord,  
and forget not the life of your poor ones for ever.**

**Arise, O God, and defend your cause,  
and forget not the cries of those who seek you.**

A reading from the first book of the Kings [19:9.11-13]  
*Stand on the mountain before the Lord.*

Responsorial Psalm [84]: **Let us see, O Lord, your mercy  
and give us your saving help.**

A reading from the letter of St Paul to the Romans [9:1-5]  
*I would willingly be condemned if it could help my brothers*

Gospel Acclamation: **Blessings on the King who comes, in the name of the Lord!  
Peace in heaven and glory in the highest heavens!**

A reading from the Gospel according to Matthew [14:22-33]  
*Tell me to come to you across the water.*

Communion Antiphon: **The bread that I will give,  
says the Lord, is my flesh for the life of the world.**

### 15<sup>th</sup> August: the Assumption – Mass at 9.30am & 7.30pm

Entrance Antiphon: **A great sign appeared in heaven:  
a woman clothed with the sun, the moon beneath her feet  
and a crown of twelve stars on her head.**

Responsorial Psalm [44]

**On your right stands the queen, in garments of gold.**

Communion antiphon: **All generations will call me blessed, for  
the Almighty has done great things for me.**

### 17 August 2014 – 20<sup>th</sup> Sunday Ordinary Time

Entrance Antiphon: **Turn your eyes, O God, our shield;  
and look on the face of your anointed one; one day  
within your courts is better than a thousand elsewhere.**

A reading from the prophet Isaiah [56:1.6-7]  
*I will bring foreigners to my holy mountain.*

Responsorial Psalm [66]: **Let the peoples praise you, O God;  
let all the peoples praise you.**

A reading from the St Paul's letter to the Romans [11:13-15. 29-32]  
*With Israel, God never takes back his gifts or revokes his choice.*

Gospel Acclamation:

**The sheep that belong to me listen to my voice,  
says the Lord, I know them and they follow me.**

A reading from the Gospel according to Matthew [15:21-28]  
*Woman, you have great faith.*

Communion Antiphon: **With the Lord there is mercy;  
in him is plentiful redemption.**

### 24 August 2014 – 21<sup>th</sup> Sunday Ordinary Time

Entrance Antiphon: **Turn your ear, O Lord, and answer me;  
save the servant who trusts in you, my God. Have mercy  
on me, O Lord, for I cry to you all the day long.**

A reading from the prophet Isaiah [22:19-23]

*I place the key of the House of David on his shoulder.*

Responsorial Psalm [137]: **Your love, O Lord, is eternal,  
discard not the word of your hands.**

A reading from the letter of St Paul to the Romans [11:33-36]  
*All that exists comes from him; all is by him and from him.*

Gospel Acclamation:

**God in Christ was reconciling the world to himself, and he  
has entrusted to us the news that they are reconciled.**

A reading from the Gospel according to Matthew [16:13-20]  
*You are Peter, and I will give you the keys  
of the kingdom of heaven.*

Communion Antiphon: **Whoever eats my flesh and  
drinks my blood has eternal life, says the Lord,  
and I will raise him up on the last day.**

---

### 31 August 2014 – 22<sup>nd</sup> Sunday Ordinary Time

Entrance Antiphon: **Have mercy on me, O Lord,  
for I cry to you all the day long. O Lord, you are  
good and forgiving, full of mercy to all who call to you.**

A reading from the prophet Jeremiah [20:7-9]  
*The word of the Lord has meant insult for me.*

Responsorial Psalm [62]

**For you my soul is thirsting, O Lord my God.**

A reading from the letter of St Paul to the Romans [12:1-2]  
*Offer your bodies as a living sacrifice.*

Gospel Acclamation: **May the Father of our Lord Jesus  
Christ enlighten the eyes of our mind,  
so that we can see what hope his call holds for us.**

A reading from the Gospel according to Matthew [16:21-27]  
*If anyone wants to be a follower of mine,  
let him renounce himself.*

Communion Antiphon: **How great is the goodness, Lord,  
that you keep for those who fear you.**
