Please complete and return this form in an envelope clearly marked with your child's name on the outside and clearly marked 'School Reference'. **To avoid any confusion:** the Parish form is not the Priest's Reference that the schools either send out or give to the parents. If you have received a Priest's Reference from the school(s) you have applied to, please follow the instructions printed on that form **AS EACH SCHOOL HAS A DIFFERENT PROCESS**. Please note: Reception and Nursery application 'drop-in' times will be available at the beginning of November.
