I was blessed this week to be part of a conference and gathering in Rome of Directors of Ongoing Formation for Clergy, attending the General Audience where Pope Francis spoke on the Church, as the Body of Christ, emphasising that "this is not simply a catchphrase: indeed, we truly are! It is the great gift that we receive on the day of our Baptism!" In speaking of this gift the Holy Father reminds us that "Christ makes us his, welcoming us into the heart of the mystery of the Cross, the supreme mystery of his love for us, in order to cause us to then be raised with him, as new beings. See: in this way the Church is born, and in this way the Church is recognized as the Body of Christ! Baptism constitutes a true rebirth, which regenerates us in Christ, renders us a part of Him, and unites us intimately among ourselves, as limbs of the same body, of which He is the Head" (cf. Rm 12:5; 1 Cor 12:12-13). By our very name, Corpus Christi parish, this encouragement speaks especially to us. As we continue to listen and grow together may we celebrate the gift of our baptism and draw our gifts together, truly becoming, more and more, 'Corpus Christi'. If you have received a Priest's Reference from the school(s) you have applied to, please follow the instructions printed on that form **AS EACH SCHOOL HAS A DIFFERENT PROCESS.** Please note: Reception and Nursery application 'drop-in' times will be available at the beginning of November.
