CAFOD has launched a £3m emergency appeal following the earthquake in Nepal. Thousands of people in this already impoverished country have been killed and many thousands more are in urgent need of food, water, shelter and emergency supplies. 8 million people are affected. CAFOD is responding with Church partners and has deployed a team to provide specialist support. To help as best we can there will be a second collection this weekend in support of CAFOD's appeal.

A small donated statue currently marks our book of prayer petitions. 
'Parish Council' Nominations 2015-2018
