CITIZENS

Lambeth Council, in partnership with Lambeth Citizens, have launched a new campaign to promote the take-up of credit union membership in Lambeth:

Lambeth Credit Union Champions. Through this scheme, Lambeth Council are offering financial incentives to encourage residents to open savings and current accounts with the London Mutual Credit Union, such as £10 upfront payment for everyone who opens a membership (savings) account and £26 for everyone who opens a current account and keeps it open for 6 months. This will be paid at the 6-month point, and covers the £1 per week account fee. Having a membership with the Credit Union will also give residents access to loan facilities (including a pay day loan), which provide an affordable alternative to high-cost high street lenders. More details are available this weekend.

Christian Life Community (CLC) is for anyone who wants to understand more deeply how God is at work in their everyday lives and is interested in Ignatian Spirituality. Two CLC groups meet in the parish regularly to pray and share. One of the groups, which meets every second Thursday from 7-8pm, is looking to welcome new members.
