Anniversary of the beatification of Charles de Foucauld Adoration of the Blessed Sacrament 10-11 am on Friday 13th November

In Britain and throughout Europe, there will be an hour of adoration and prayer on 13th November to mark the tenth anniversary of the beatification of Charles de Foucauld. This will begin the events which will lead to the centenary of Br. Charles' death on 1st December 1916. After the 9:30 Mass on 13th November, there will be an hour of adoration in the church and all are welcome to attend.

A rota for hourly or two hourly periods for members of the Parish to sign up is in the porch. The quietest periods are from 11 am until 5pm and we need at least two people for each hour. Although the Hall will be closed during this time Volunteers will have access to use the facilities. If we have enough volunteers sign up, we will hold a meeting to discuss arrangements, so please consider becoming a founding member of our **Church Guardians**, thank you.
