Following the devastating terror attacks throughout Paris the Vatican Press Office has voiced its dismay over the events: "We are shocked by this new manifestation of maddening, terrorist violence and hatred which we condemn in the most radical way together with the Pope and all those who love peace," Holy See press office director Fr. Federico Lombardi said in a statement. "We pray for the victims and the wounded, and for all the French people. This is an attack on peace for all humanity, and it requires a decisive, supportive response on the part of all of us as we counter the spread the homicidal hatred in all of its forms."

Fr Adrian, one of the Chaplains for the Lambeth Metropolitan Police will be in Rome this week at a conference with the Holy Father. During that time our Parish is hosting a Lambeth Multifaith Action Group and Faiths Together in Lambeth meeting with Police Inspector Jack Rowlands on the theme 'We Stand Together'. This is a community led initiative in partnership with police across the country. Commander Mak Chishty, the Scotland Yard lead on 'We Stand Together' will be present so please join us in the Parish Hall from 6-8 pm on Wednesday 18 November.

South London Citizens Delegates Assembly have a meeting on 18 November 6.30 - 8.30 pm at the William Booth College, Champion Park, SE5 8BQ. This meeting is to plan for the campaign for the London Mayoral election in May 2016. We all are all affected by the housing crisis in London. This Assembly will look at the issues which concern all.
