Many of our Parish families are away at Easter and miss our Easter celebrations as a parish. The three days of Holy Week known as the Triduum (Holy Thursday, Good Friday and the Easter Vigil) are a beautiful and moving liturgy. This year we have, over the Easter period, six children and nine adults who will be baptised and seventeen adults who will be confirmed, most of these at the Easter Vigil on 26 March at 7.30pm.
