A Youth Event Celebrating the Year of Mercy

"Touched by His Merciful Hands" is to take place at Holy Ghost Catholic Church, Balham SW12 8QJ on Friday, 13th May at 7:30 pm. The event features a guest-speaker, Meg Kilmer-Hunter and gives time for the Sacrament of Confession, Eucharistic Adoration and a social time at the end. All youth are welcome.

Spirit in the City is a celebration of Christian faith in the heart of London,

organised by Catholic communities in the West End. The annual festival aims to share the Good news of Christianity, and welcomes people of all faiths, ages and walks of life in the middle of the entertainment district. It gives an opportunity to raise deeper questions about life. We are all searching for new ways to connect with God and others around us. The events feature live music, workshops, talks, opportunities for prayer, reflection and reconciliation. Spirit in the City was born as an initiative of the local churches in 2006, as response to the desire to share something of the Catholic faith with visitors and the West End community. The festival takes place in June over three-four days. It includes different types of prayer, talks about faith and outreach in the programme.

Pope Francis has appointed Father Paul Mason as the new Auxiliary Bishop of Southwark.

Fr Mason, a priest of the Archdiocese of Southwark, has been the Episcopal Vicar for Kent which comprises the Deaneries of Canterbury, Chatham, Dover, Gravesend, Maidstone, Thanet and Tunbridge Wells. The Episcopal Ordination of Bishop-Elect Paul Mason will take place in St. George's Cathedral, Southwark, on 31st May, 2016 at midday, the Feast of the Visitation of the Blessed Virgin Mary. He will join Bishop Patrick Lynch and Bishop Paul Hendricks as Auxiliary Bishops of the Diocese of Southwark, succeeding Bishop John Hine. Bishop Elect Paul Mason said: "I look forward to continuing my ministry with Archbishop Peter and to do all I can to support and promote the Catholic Faith and help share the love and mercy of God, particularly to the people of Kent and the Medway." A short biography of Fr Paul Mason: Born 6 November 1962 in North Shields, Tyne & Wear. Attended St. Anselm's Roman Catholic High School, North Shields, and Kings College London. Worked in Turin for Olivetti and in London for Hewlett-Packard until September 1992. Seminary Training: Venerable English College, Rome. Ordained Priest 25th July 1998. Assistant priest at Saint John the Baptist, Purley (1998 - 2001). Full time Hospital Chaplain at St. Thomas' & Guys Hospital Trust (2001 - 2012). Pastoral Director, Allen Hall Seminary and Director of Southwark Ongoing Formation for Priests (2012 - 2013), Episcopal Vicar for Kent 2013 to the present day.
