Please join us this coming Wednesday for Mass at 9.30 am and 7.30 pm on the Holy Day of Obligation for the Feast of St Peter and St Paul. Pupils from Corpus Christi School will join our 9.30 Mass and the 7.30pm Mass will take place in the context of an open Catechism meeting from 7-8.30 pm, looking at the structure of the Mass and how we can fully participate. The evening Mass is open to anyone but any parent of a child eligible to apply for First Holy Communion or Confirmation should attend this Mass please as part one of two introductory sessions that outline the meaning of the Sacraments and the ways parents can help their children to grow in the faith. The second compulsory class is on Wednesday 13 July from 7.30-8.30pm. Please see Fr Adrian if you can't make this Wednesday, as applications for First Holy Communion or Confirmation are available after a parent has attended both Catechism sessions, thank you.

#### A Prayer by Anne Osdieck

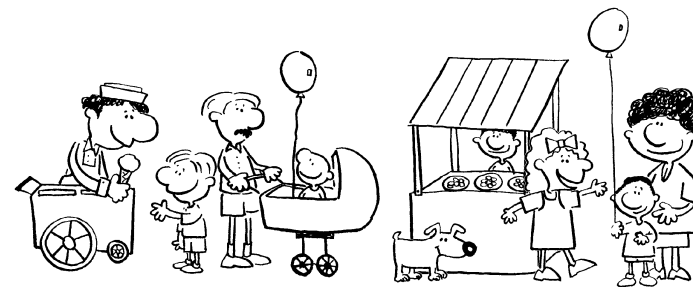
Jesus, when you say, "Follow me," you ask so much from us. You ask us for everything. Please deepen our trust.

Let us pack our bags lightly then go where you call us.

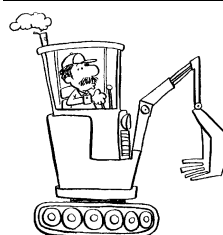
Loosen our untold attachments, and whatever fastens us to our safe spots.

The remedial repairs and the refurbishment work to the Presbytery have begun in earnest over the last couple of weeks and will last until September. During this time, 11 Trent Road will be an off-limits building site and the Parish Office will be based in the Repository. Although mail can still be posted through the door, please don't ring the bell as the workmen won't be able to help! Please note, volunteers help in the Parish Office in the Repository from 10am-1pm Monday to Thursday only, but our current hours will remain the same, wherever possible, with the office open 10am-1pm Monday to Friday. Voicemails can be left outside of these times when the office is closed. As the Presbytery will be uninhabitable for about three months, I am currently living at St George's Cathedral and have joined the life of so many parishioners who have a daily commute (it's a bit longer than the usual walk across the road to the church!) I am usually working around the parish from 8.30am-5.30pm and then have evening appointments from 6 pm to 8.30 pm at Archbishop's House, SE1 6HY. NB Tuesday is normally the one day a week when I am not in the Parish. Please contact me through the Repository during the Parish Office hours, although voicemails can be left when the Parish Office is engaged or closed by dialling 020 7274 4625 (the normal Parish number has been transferred to the Repository). If you need to contact me in an emergency you may leave a message via the pager operator on 07623 194620, but please note, this is not a mobile phone and cannot take messages sent by text.
