First Holy Communion and Confirmation News



Thank you for the tremendously positive response we have had from the parents and children of those eligible for to apply for the Sacramental Programmes which begin this Autumn. To date we have had **70** First Holy Communion enquiries and **40** Confirmation enquiries, although it is expected that these numbers will rise. **If you missed the Catechesis meeting for Parents on 13 July, then please see Fr Adrian to collect the actual application form for the programmes, but please keep 21 September from 7.30-9 pm free as this is a 'catch-up' session for all eligible parents who missed either 29 June or 13 July.**

Given the tremendous numbers of potential Candidates and the relatively few numbers of parents to help with Catechesis, following last year's trial of running the **First Holy Communion** classes as an after-school activity, it is planned to respond to the needs of the children by forming two groups: one on a **Thursday from 3.30-4.30 pm** for children at Corpus Christi school and a second group for children attending other schools. The first group may be about sixty in number and the second group may have up to twenty children. Given these numbers, depending on the availability of parents to help with catechesis, **the smaller group may be meeting on a Sunday from 4.30-5.30 pm. However, if Catechists and parents are available, it may be possible to hold this on a Thursday from 4-5 pm instead.** If you have been involved as a Communion Catechist in the past or would be interested and could be available to help (on either a Sunday or a Thursday, please see Fr Adrian in person after Mass), thank you. It is planned that we keep the night of our Confirmation classes to a Friday evening, as in previous years, but it is proposed that after a weekly introduction during Advent, the Confirmation programme would then become every other week from January (in term-time only), leading up to **the Sacrament of Confirmation which will be celebrated by Archbishop Peter Smith on June 11 at 3 pm.** The exact details of both programmes will follow in due course, once we are aware of the number of Catechists and helpers. Come September we will plan a meeting for all the catechists to discuss when best to hold the sessions depending on their availability. **The majority hope that Confirmation will be from 7 to 8.15 on a Friday but some have asked for other days. We open to suggestions and will plan according to how many candidates and helpers we have. If you have any views on the timings or would like to help as a catechist for First Holy Communion or Confirmation, please see Fr Adrian.**

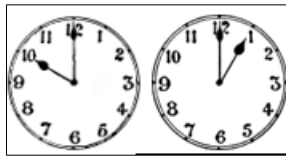

Have you ever wondered if you could hire the Hall?

We are blessed to have a small group of three people who volunteer to help keep our hall clean during the week, but each group who use the hall, including our Sunday Refreshment Team, are responsible for leaving the Parish Hall as good as, if not better, than it was found. Joining this small team in helping to care for the Hall is Conor Carroll, a young Catholic entrepreneur who has started a management company (Praetorium) to help local Catholic parishes ensure their halls can be more available to be hired to raise much needed funds for the parish. The Hall is now booked for a self-defence class on Monday nights and there is the potential for a children's dance class on Saturday mornings. If both classes can use the Hall we would receive a much needed £5000 a year. Changes to our Sacramental programmes mean that the Hall can be available then and can be free to be booked most Saturday afternoons as well. **To help raise funds for the Parish please spread the word to your family and friends that the Hall is available to hire.** Our hall is ideal for holding children's parties (up to age 12), group meetings, fitness classes, after school activities and concerts. Any parishioner registered with the Parish is entitled to a reduction to £25 per hour from the usual hire fee of £40 an hour. **For further information or to book the Hall please use the dedicated Hall Hire phone number 01372 457651.**
