**CAN YOU HELP?** Many of you will be aware that a serious incident occurred at the 9am Mass on Christmas Day when three parishioners were assaulted and the beginning of Mass was disrupted, resulting in the police having to be called to make an arrest. We have some CCTV images of the incident and need your help. Please check the photo on the right and the poster in the porch and see Fr Adrian if you know the blonde-haired lady in a red-trimmed black jumper with white spots and a reindeer motif. The person who was arrested approached this visitor, leaving her visibly distressed. He then went on to physically attack three parish members. Our concern is threefold: to care for all those who were attacked, for the unnamed visitor who was distressed and to form a **team of ushers at each Mass to help prevent or manage any future situations.** If you would be happy to be part of a team and be on a rota for each Mass, please see Fr Adrian. Once we have enough volunteers we will arrange a training and safety session. As a result of previous incidents, Fr Adrian applied for a Home Office Grant and we learnt just before Christmas that we will be given £7000 to develop our CCTV and alarm system over the next couple of months. Finally, if you see the person arrested (shown in the poster in the porch) around the church again, please dial 999 immediately as his bail conditions exclude him from approaching the church. If you have any questions about this please see Fr Adrian or Fr David. Thank you.
