We walk towards the city.

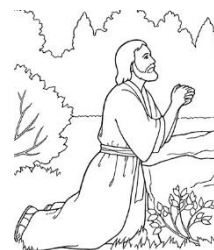
We wait in the garden.

Thank you to everyone who will be helping this weekend with our Palm Sunday Celebrations.

The three days of Holy Week known as the Triduum (Holy Thursday, Good Friday and the Easter Vigil) are a beautiful and moving liturgy. We receive the Holy Oils from the Cathedral and celebrate Christian Service with the Washing of the Feet on Holy (Maundy) Thursday. We have the Stations of the Cross with children and families on Good Friday before our Solemn Liturgy and reverencing of the Cross at 3pm. This year we have, over the Easter period, four adult Catechumens who will be baptised, joined with one Candidate for their Confirmation. Most of these will be at the Easter Vigil on 15 April at 7.30 pm, a tremendous celebration, beginning in the darkness as we gather by the Holy Fire in the main garden in front of the Church. After the blessing of the Paschal Candle we move into the church for the Service of Light and the proclamation of Easter joy with the singing of the Exsultet. We then move into a series of readings celebrating the Exodus of God's people and continue into our Mass with the celebration of the Sacraments where we welcome the newest members of our Parish into the life of the Church. Our Vigil is due to end at approximately 9.30 pm when all are welcome to refreshments in the hall afterwards. **Please note there will be no 6pm Mass on Easter Sunday.**
