If your child is entering reception class in primary school at the start of the 2013/14 academic year (September 2013) and was born between 1 September 2008 and 31 August 2009, you need to apply for a Lambeth school place for them. However, the application deadline for **all children is 15 January 2013**. Any applications received after this date will not be processed as an on-time application, which could result in your child missing out on an offer from a school of your choice. Please apply on time!
