Funeral Arrangements for Fr. Tom at Corpus Christi

17 March at 6.00pm Fr Tom will be brought into the church. The church will be open until late to accommodate everyone. *This may be the best opportunity for parishioners to pay their last respects to Fr Tom..* The church will be open until 10 pm.

The Parish Hall will be open for refreshments after the service and donations of food and drink would be appreciated.

18 March 2013 at 12 noon will be the Requiem. The Diocesan priests and Fr Tom's family will be in attendance and therefore seating at this service will be limited although provision is being made to accommodate extra numbers in the Parish Hall and outside in the front garden. The service is expected to last for about 2½ hours and those parishioners not able to be seated should bear in mind the weather conditions and dress accordingly. There will be a reception in the School Hall following the service. Donations of finger food should be brought to the school hall by 11am

Good Friday: There will be Stations of the Cross at 10.30 am for families with young children but ALL are welcome of course. This will be followed by walking silently in to the hall for a hot cross bun.
